The time has come for you to visit Bolesławiec. In this exercise, your job is to help Piotr with choosing the perfect ceramics for his store. Work in pairs. Visit the websites and choose <u>five</u> items that you believe tourists and other customers would buy from his store. Make sure you write at least two sentences about every item you recommend to Piotr. Use the wordbank provided below to help you with your descriptions.

- 1. Describe the item. Tell him about the size, the shape, the pattern.
- 2. Tell him why the item would sell well.

EXAMPLE: I would like to recommend this tall, round, navy-blue teacup with flowery pattern. I think this cup would sell well because it is reasonably priced, pretty and practical.

WORDBANK

You can use the following adjectives to describe the pottery. Consult a dictionary if needed:

SIZE: Large, small, tiny, huge, tall, short.

SHAPE: round, square, rectangular, oval, tubular, broad, narrow, flat, eye-shaped, triangular.

PATTERNS: flowery/floral, spotted, dotted, wavy, striped.

OTHER USEFUL WORDS: with a handle (the part of a mug or a pot that allows you to hold it), a saucer (the tiny plate you put underneath a teacup), tureen (a large dish in which soup is served), creamer (a container holding milk for tea or coffee).

REMEMBER: The order of adjectives in the descriptions should be as follows:

- [1] Quantity or number.
- [2] Quality or opinion.
- [3] Size.
- [4] Shape.
- [5] Color.

EXAMPLE: Two beautiful tiny round red coffee cups.
