PROJECT WORK

An agrarian custom, structured after carols, going with the 'buhai' (a special drum caused to boom by pulling on a tuft of hair attached to it) is a tradition kept for centuries in Romanian villages. The buhai custom is practiced on New Year's Eve, between dusk and midnight. The object itself is a churn with one of the ends covered by a stretched piece of sheepskin. from the center of which hangs a horsehair mane, which produces a solemn, strange and unmusical sound, reminiscent of a bull's roar. Sometimes the buhai is adorned with ram's horns wrapped in colorful paper, and tassels. The groups of well-wishers wear traditional costumes adorned with hats, whips and bells, being fondly received by the hosts, who reward them with apples, nuts, pretzels and knot-shaped breads.
