Dubrovnik Musket-bearing Guard of Honour is historical army unit founded in 1417. These musket-bearers (trombunjeri) are participating in all major events in Dubrovnik and across Croatia. Their most important role is the guiding of procession on the feast of the patron saint, St. Blaise, on the third February which is the celebration day of city Dubrovnik.

Step 1. Get together in the groups of 3-4 people. Discuss the tasks that you have to perform, their order, and the division of work.

Step 2. Here are some additional questions that may help you work on the content of your presentation:

- What do they usually wear?
- What do they do in the morning of St. Blaise?
- Where do they fire?
- Explain the rich history of trombunjeri?
- How did they celebrate festivity in 1992?
- What are trombunjeri responsible for?
